#### Section A

# Practical work completed during the course

You must answer **all** questions in this section.

At the beginning of your answer, you must state the title of your piece of practical work.

#### **Question 1**

Choose **one** piece of practical work that you have completed during the course, working as an actor **or** designer **or** technician. **All** of your answers must be about the **same** piece of practical work.

You need to focus specifically on your **individual** contribution to the piece of practical work and the **same** selected skill.

- **0 1** Describe your piece of practical work; include reference to **all** of the following:
  - whether you were involved as an actor **or** designer **or** technician
  - the genre of the piece
  - the style of the piece
  - the period of the piece
  - the performance space used and how it was configured
  - your target audience
  - any technical/design elements used in the piece (if applicable).

Explain how you prepared for your piece of practical work with reference to your chosen skill, giving **two** specific examples from the rehearsal process.

[10 marks]

Analyse how your practical skills improved during the rehearsal process, giving **two** specific examples of when you showed improvement as an actor **or** designer **or** technician.

**0 4** Evaluate how successful your contribution was to the final performance for your target audience, giving **two** specific examples where you felt you achieved your aims.

# Study and performance of a scripted play

Answer **one** question **either** from this section **or** from Section C.

Answer **both** parts of the question that you chose.

You must **not** use the same piece of practical work that you used to answer Section A.

If you worked as an **actor** you should answer Question 2, and if you worked as a **designer** or **technician** you should answer Question 3.

At the beginning of your answer, state the title of the play **and** the name of the playwright.

**0 5** Explain how you developed your acting skills, giving **three** specific examples from the rehearsal process that helped you to create the character(s) you played.

You should discuss your research, rehearsal techniques, and any work that you did with the script.

**0 6** Evaluate how successful you were in using your physical and vocal skills to communicate your character(s) to the audience in the final performance, giving **three** specific examples where you were particularly effective.

**O 7** Explain how you developed your design **or** technical skill, giving **three** specific examples from the rehearsal process that helped you to develop your skill.

You should discuss your research, work in rehearsals, and any work that you did with the script.

**0** 8 Evaluate how successful you were in realising your skill, giving **three** specific examples from the final performance where you contributed effectively to the success of the piece.

**1 1** Explain why the design **or** technical skill was particularly successful, giving **three** specific examples from the extract where this skill made an impact on you.

You should discuss how the skill you have chosen enhanced this extract in the production.

1 2 Evaluate the design **or** technical skill in the production you saw, giving **three** specific examples from this extract where you felt this skill enhanced the style of the production.

You should discuss the production style in relation to the original play you studied.
